We know that when he appears, we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is. Everyone who has this hope in him purifies himself, just as he is pure. (1 John 3:2-3, NIV)

## The Flame of Hope

The beauty of Christ and our hope in Him causes the world to fade away. What are the world and all its short-lived attractions in comparison to an eternity of oneness with Christ and rich life in Him?
