Read Luke 3:1-6

While most people, even God's people, were preoccupied with the world's celebrities, God's living, sovereign, creative word was coming to a man alone in the desert. He had none of the world's soft clothing, soft ways, or soft words. Everything about him was raw and real. He was a voice crying in the wilderness, in the world's wildest, most untamed place.
